PGS Certification Procedures

1. Initial Contact:

Reach out to our office via phone, email, or visit our website for preliminary information.

2. Information Session:

Attend an introductory session to learn about PGS certification, its benefits, and the application process.

3. Application Submission:

Complete and submit the PGS Certification Application Form along with necessary documents, such as farm records and proof of organic practices by visiting https://pgsindia-ncof.gov.in/PGSI/user/register.

4. Preliminary Assessment:

Our team will conduct an on-site visit to evaluate your farming practices and ensure they align with organic standards after receiving application in PGS Portal.

5. Training and Workshops:

Participate in training sessions on PGS standards, organic farming techniques, and proper record-keeping.

6. Peer Review Process:

Engage in peer reviews where fellow farmers assess each other's practices to ensure mutual compliance with organic standards.

7. Final Inspection:

Undergo a detailed inspection by our certifying officers who will verify adherence to PGS standards.

8. Evaluation and Decision:

Based on the inspection report, the certification committee will make a decision regarding your certification status.

9. Certification Issuance:

If approved, you will receive the PGS certification, which is valid for a specified period and must be renewed annually.
